

BUILDING A CABIN IN GRAHAM TOWNSHIP

1. The resident needs to get a Recreational Cabin Affidavit from the township office. Complete, sign and notarize. The affidavit should be filed in the township office and a copy made for the resident. By signing the affidavit the resident is attesting to the following:
 - a. Will be used for recreational use only
 - b. Will not be used as a residence
 - c. Will not be used for commercial purposes
 - d. Will not exceed two stories in height
 - e. Will not be used as a place of employment
 - f. Will not be a mailing address
 - g. Will not listed as a residence on tax records, driver's license, vehicle registration or voter registration.
2. A permit is not required by the township or Guardian Inspection Services.
3. Sewage
 - a. If the cabin does not have water under pressure, a privy is permitted. Contact Terry Wilkinson, SEO
 - b. If the cabin has water under pressure, contact Terry Wilkinson for a sewage application.
